Tuition is provided on the following terms:

1. The vessel is insured by the owner for loss, damage and legal liability to third parties, including the instructor.
2. The owner remains the Skipper and also legally responsible for the safe control and management of the crew and the vessel at all times, (including when under tuition), and will not intend or seek to hold the instructor or crew responsible for any damage or loss.
3. The owner undertakes to secure the consent of his/her Insurers to the contents of this agreement.
4. The vessel should be suitable for the presentation of the course.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT AND CHECKLIST BEFORE

LEAVING BERTH.

1. Fuel tank/s full, and spare fuel available -----
2. Fire extinguishers readily available and in date-----
3. Main engine fully serviced & functional -----
4. Alternative means of propulsion - paddles available -----
5. Anchor with suitable length of chain & rope -----
6. First Aid Kit, Survival bag/s -----
7. Knife, Bailer, Torch & batteries -----
8. Signal Flares & Rockets – ALL in DATE -----
9. VHF Radio, preferably main and hand - held -----
10. Sound signal (gas foghorn) -----
11. Towing or long rope (at least 15/20 metres) -----
12. Fenders (sufficient in numbers and size for boat) -----
13. Relevant Charts, Plotting Instruments, pencils & erasers -----
14. Tidal and Port information for projected voyages -----
15. Air pump or bellows if boat is a RIB -----
16. Lifejackets and to be worn by all aboard -----
17. Boathooks / Mooring ropes of sufficient length -----
18. Hand held Bearing Compass -- Recommended -----
